## Hidden Vale Wildlife Conservation Top Up Scholarships

## Eligibility

This scholarship is open to Doctor of Philosophy candidates researching wildlife conservation.

To be eligible you must:

- Complete this PhD full-time and onshore in Australia.
- Be nominated by an enrolling school or institute at UQ.
- Be assessed by the Graduate School as meeting all conditions for admission to the research higher degree program.
- Future students will also need to satisfy the entry requirements for Higher Degrees by Research at UQ and conditions for a Research Training Program (RTP) or equivalent living allowance scholarship from UQ's Graduate School.
- Applicants **must** be in receipt of, or apply for and be awarded, either a full Australian Government Research Training Program (TRP) Scholarhip or a UQ-funded scholarship to be eligible to receive this top-up.

Details you need to provide:

- Your Surname, first name, contact phone number and email address.
- Whether you are you a current or prospective PhD student within the Hidden Vale Project
- Your proposed thesis title
- Proposed (or actual) commencement date (*Include research quarter and year*)
- Expected completion date (*Research quarter and year*)
- Attach evidence of living allowance (current students) or evidence of having applied for a living allowance (prospective students). This should be uploaded. Allowed file type(s): .doc; .docx; .jpeg; .jpg; .pdf; .png

- Proposed project description In approximately 500 words, you will need to provide an overview of your aims, background and expected outcomes. You are able to attach a file if preferred.
- A list of your Advisory Team. You will need the full name, institution and school for all of your advisors, and whether they have confirmed their support.
- You will need to supply a letter of motivation, explaining why your project should be supported by a Hidden Vale Wildlife Conservation top up scholarship. You need to include how your project will help achieve the aims of the Hidden Vale Wildlife Project. A note such as "this will give me more money to live on" will not be accepted. You are able to attach a file for this response.
- You will need to upload your academic transcripts and evidence of award of degrees in one file.
- You will need to provide details of two academic referees, including their title, name, email, phone, affiliation, and details of your relationship with the referee.
